1. TERMS OF WEBSITE USE

- 1.1 This page (together with the documents referred to on it) tells you the terms of use on which you may make use of our website kymallanhsc.co.uk (our site), whether as a guest or a registered user. Please read these terms of use carefully before you start to use the site. By using our site, you indicate that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to abide by them. If you do not agree to these terms of use, please refrain from using our site.

2. INFORMATION ABOUT US

- 2.2 We are a limited company.

3. ACCESSING OUR SITE

- 3.1 Access to our site is permitted on a temporary basis, and we reserve the right to withdraw or amend the service we provide on our site without notice (see below). Whilst all reasonable measures are taken by us to ensure that this website is operational all day, every day, occasionally technical issues may result in some downtime and accordingly we will not be liable if this website is unavailable at any time or for any period.
